Escort is simply the most versatile speaker you'll find. At home indoors and out, Escort may be wall-mounted, pole-mounted, soffit-mounted or even concealed behind the leaves of potted plants. Take Escort poolside or place on a bookshelf.

Since Escort's 5.25" woofer and dome tweeter are magnetically shielded, it can be used to upgrade your computer speakers or as a killer center channel for your home theater.

Before you purchase loudspeaker wire, check local building codes to make sure that the wire is rated to comply with applicable local safety codes such as UL or CL-2. Use only stranded wire no thinner than AWG 16. For runs longer than 100 feet, we recommend minimum of AWG 14. When pulling wire, take care not to pull the wire too fast to prevent stretching the wire or scorching the insulation from friction. Leave 2 to 3 feet of excess loudspeaker wire at both ends; it is easier to trim off excess wire than to splice additional wire. When securing the wire inside the walls, be careful not to pierce the insulation with nails or staples.

Installing the Escort On-Wall Loudspeakers

- 1. Find a stud in your wall or a solid mounting surface where you would like the escort to be mounted. It is best to mount the brackets to a stud in your wall, otherwise the weight and vibrations from the speaker could cause it to become unattached from the wall.
- 2. Fasten the supplied mounting bracket to the wall with screws.
- 3. Connect your speaker wire to the Escort connection plate.
- 4. Place Escort in the mounting bracket and fasten with the black connectors.
- 5. Adjust the speaker to the direction of your desired listening location and enjoy.
